

Is 650-543-4800 Facebook?*customer support number*

Many people search [\[1-\(803\)2505496\]](tel:1-(803)2505496) online after seeing the phone number **650-543-4800**, wondering if it belongs to Facebook and whether [\[1-\(803\)2505496\]](tel:1-(803)2505496) it can be used for [\[1-\(803\)2505496\]](tel:1-(803)2505496) customer support. The 650 area [\[1-\(803\)2505496\]](tel:1-(803)2505496) code serves Silicon [\[1-\(803\)2505496\]](tel:1-(803)2505496) Valley, where many major technology companies are based. Because of this, the number is legitimate in a [\[1-\(803\)2505496\]](tel:1-(803)2505496) corporate sense and has been publicly associated with Facebook/Meta for years.

However, this does [\[1-\(803\)2505496\]](tel:1-(803)2505496) **not** mean it functions as a customer service phone line for Facebook users. Facebook does **not** offer traditional [\[1-\(803\)2505496\]](tel:1-(803)2505496) phone-based [\[1-\(803\)2505496\]](tel:1-(803)2505496) customer support for most users. If you call this number hoping to fix issues such as a hacked account, login problems, [\[1-\(803\)2505496\]](tel:1-(803)2505496) disabled profiles, or [\[1-\(803\)2505496\]](tel:1-(803)2505496) advertising disputes, you are unlikely to reach a live support agent.
